

**PAINTBALL ASSUMPTION OF RISK & LIABILITY RELEASE
HEAVENLY HILLS CHRISTIAN CAMP**

WHILE HEAVENLY HILLS CHRISTIAN CAMP MAKES EVERY EFFORT TO PROVIDE A SAFE, FUN PAINTBALL EXPERIENCE FOR EVERYONE, WE REQUIRE PAINTBALL PARTICIPANTS AND A PARENT/GUARDIAN (IF PARTICIPANT IS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE) READ, SIGN, AND DATE THIS RELEASE.

PAINTBALL FIELD RULES

Field Rules

- "Field Paint Only" – Paint checks will occur randomly throughout the day. Anyone with outside paint will be banned from play.
- Approved paintball safety goggle systems (including full face and ear protection) must be worn at all times while on the field. This is critical and will be strongly enforced.
- Barrel bags MUST be worn on all markers at ALL times when outside of the play field. Markers are to be pointed in a safe direction (up or down), with fingers OFF the trigger. No shooting or dry firing anywhere outside the field of play.
- All guns must be chronoed and tagged by a referee. The radar maximum speed is 270-fps for all caliber paintball guns.
- NO tools allowed on the field by participants. The referee stationed in the Safety Zone will be able to assist you if you need assistance with maintenance issues.
- A paintball that breaks counts as a hit; if a paintball hits you but doesn't break, yell 'No Break' and continue playing. Remember, splatter doesn't matter.
- Do NOT OVERSHOOT! Hitting a player exiting play will result in your exit.
- Show Mercy
 - Within 20 feet offer mercy; does not have to take it
 - Within 10 feet announce "MERCY"; mercy must be accepted
- Once you are eliminated, immediately put your barrel bag on, keep your marker pointed high in the air, yell "OUT" and head for the reinsertion zone. Remember, dead men don't talk or pass supplies to other players.
- Do NOT use another player or referee as cover. Phony gestures to give the presumption of being out will result in you being out. Do not leave the marked boundaries – Do so and you'll be out. Remember, no barrel bag and you are still someone else's target.
- Check with the lead referee on the use of paint grenades and paint mines.
- When the air horn sounds STOP shooting IMMEDIATELY. Put your barrel bag on, raise your marker over your head, and listen for instructions from the lead referee. The air horn may sound when the game is over or when play needs to be stopped for whatever reason.
- Cheaters will not be tolerated. Any player caught playing with obvious hits or altering their equipment will be ejected and may be banned from future play.
- NO physical contact between players.
- NO verbal/physical obscenities or gestures. This is a Christian camp. We expect conduct to honor the Lord.
- The referee's call is final. Never argue with the referee.
- DO NOT shoot referees, animals or anyone wearing hunter orange.
- No climbing trees.
- No tools, knives, fireworks, lighters, matches, or smoking is allowed on the field.
- Illegal drugs, alcohol, and unapproved solicitations are prohibited on the premises.

I have (my child has) voluntarily applied to participate in paintball and agree to abide by the field rules while participating in the paintball activity at Heavenly Hills Christian Camp. I, we, understand paintball has inherited risks and dangers. I accept full responsibility for any injury or accident to me (or my child) that may occur as a result of participation in paintball activities at Heavenly Hills Christian Camp.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS RELEASE AND FULLY UNDERSTAND ITS CONTENTS. FURTHERMORE, I RELEASE HEAVENLY HILLS CHRISTIAN CAMP, ITS TRUSTEES, EMPLOYEES, AND AGENTS FROM ANY PHYSICAL INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, WHILE PARTICIPATING IN PAINTBALL AT HEAVENLY HILLS CHRISTIAN CAMP.
