Heavenly Hills Christian Camp 2011

Everything is important, please read carefully!

The purpose of this sheet is to help you prepare for your camp experience at Heavenly Hills. We want you to have a great time!

Check-in is at the Picnic Tables outside the lodge!

When you arrive...

Campgrounds & Canteen open at 4:00pm on Sunday

All camp programs will check-in at the picnic tables outside the lodge. Your cabin or sleeping area will be pre-assigned based on the cabinmate that you submitted on your registration form. Check-in will not begin before 4:00pm!

What to bring

- Bible, pencil, paper, stamps, etc.
- Clothing (please note clothing rule). Please bring clothing that can take a week of camp (including a jacket) and mark your stuff with your name!
- Bedding or sleeping bag
- Towels, soap, toothbrush, etc.
- Swim suits, cameras, sunscreen, bug spray

When you arrive at camp between 4:00 and 5:30 p.m., come to the picnic tables outside the lodge to check-in. Please make sure that you arrive by 5:30pm. If you are unable to arrive on time or are not going to be able to attend, please notify the office at 209-586-1306. Once arriving, you will proceed through this process:

1. Health screening: Temperatures will be taken along with a very brief current medical history. If the camper's temperature is over 100.4°, they will wait for 15 minutes to see if their temperature decreases. If it does not, they will have to return home until their fever breaks.
2. Medications: Medication (in the original container) will be turned in to the Health Supervisor, along with any changes in health from the original health record.
3. Fees due or other registration issues? There will be two check-in lines. One for fees paid and one for fees still due. At that time you will receive your canteen/mission cards, wrist bands (for junior and beginner campers) and room assignments.

Visitors

Outside visitors (parents too), phone calls, etc. are discouraged during camp. If a camper must be contacted, please contact the camp office first at 209.586.1306.

Dismissal Information

Grades 2-6 will receive a wristband that is numbered. It will have a detachable tab with the same number that the parent will take home. After the closing rally, or at your child's dismissal time, you will pick up your child at the field by presenting your tab to their counselor. If you lose or forget your tab, make sure you bring a picture ID! After picking up your child, you may pick up your child's camper packet and any medicine at the picnic tables next to the lodge.

Saturday Schedule

Camp dismisses at 11:00 am with a rally for the campers and parents at 10:00. Parents can begin arriving at 9:30 a.m.

Camp Times

Beginners Camp

Sessions begin at 4:00pm Wednesday and end at 11:00am Saturday

Junior Camp & Jr/Sr High Camp

Sessions begin at 6:00 pm Sunday and end at 11:00 am Saturday.

It Is To Your Advantage to pay your fees in full at least two weeks before camp. Payments made in office a few days before camp may not be posted by registration day. You may still have to go through the "payment due" line.

Camp Rules

Your program director will fill you in more completely when you arrive.

- 1** Every person is expected to conduct themselves in a Christian manner.
- 2** No one is permitted to leave the campgrounds without the permission of the Program Director.
- 3** The use of tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs is strictly prohibited.
- 4** ALL medications are to be turned into the Health Supervisor in their ORIGINAL PACKAGING.
- 5** Clothing: Please be modest in your clothing. No two-piece bathing suits...and swimwear is for water games and swimming only. Please keep your shorts to at least mid-thigh length with a natural waist, and must be kept up so underwear is covered. Bare midriff, low cut, backless, sleeveless, or spaghetti strap shirts are not allowed. Due to the terrain, shoes worn outside must be closed toed.
- 6** Radios, MP3 players, computers, cell phones, pagers, video games, and other electronics need to be left at home. Any of these items found will be confiscated until end of camp.
- 7** Campers are not allowed in or around cabins of the opposite sex.
- 8** Snacks, candy, and other food items are not allowed in cabins.
- 9** We reserve the right to dismiss any camper for undesirable conduct.

Early Dismissal

We hope that all campers will be able to stay their whole week of camp, but we understand that may not always be able to happen. If you are going to need an early dismissal of your child, here is what you will need to do. On check-in day, you will be required to fill out an Early Dismissal Form at the Registration Table, that informs us of when and who will pick up your camper. When you come to pick up your child, you must bring your "receipt" to the office.

Health and Safety

Each camp session there is a trained Health Supervisor on-site to address health and safety concerns. We will attempt to notify you if your camper becomes ill or sustains an injury. Please fill your health form out as accurately and completely as possible....this is very important! Insurance claims will be filed in the parent's name with the information supplied on the camper's health card. HHCC DOES NOT PROVIDE INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR CAMPERS UNLESS THEY HAVE NO INSURANCE OF THEIR OWN.
