

Camp Rules



1. **Respect** – All visitors are expected to conduct themselves with respect to each other, themselves, and to the facilities.
2. **Parking Problems** – All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas, not blocking camp roads or trails.
3. **Dishes** – After meals, dishes go in the designated Dish tubs in the Dining Hall. All cups, mugs, plates, and silverware must stay in the Dining Hall. For second helpings, campers must dispose of their dishes in the Dish tubs and get a new plate.
4. **Camp Security** – Our Camp Security are our two dogs, a medium-sized brindle and a black/white short husky mix. Please do not feed them.
5. **Game Room** – Any campers under 14 years old who are using the Game Room must have Adult Supervision
6. **No Pets** – Campers bringing pets are not allowed unless they are certifiable service providers. If you are bringing a service pet, the Camp Office must be notified at least a week prior to the camp or retreat.
7. **No Pranks** – We do not allow any pranks (big or small) at Heavenly Hills because retaliation tends to escalate and ultimately something/someone ends up breaking.
8. **Opposite Gender Areas** – Campers are not allowed in or around housing or restroom areas of the opposite sex.
9. **No Food or Drink** – There is no food or drinks other than water allowed inside any of the housing facilities. Food, drinks, or snacks must be stored either in the Kitchen Area or in the Canteen. Any food or drink items bought from the Canteen must be consumed before returning to your housing.
10. **No Smoking, Vaping, Alcohol, Fireworks, Weapons, or Illegal Substances** – None of these substances or materials are allowed on Camp property
11. **Amplified Sound Curfew** – From 9PM to 8AM there is no amplified sound allowed outside. We do this to respect our neighbors and our Staff.

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- 12. Fire** — Fire of any kind (campfire, wood-stove fire, etc.) may only be operated by Heavenly Hills Staff. Campers are not allowed to put anything in or take anything out of any fires unless given permission by the Heavenly Hills Staff. S'mores' are permitted.
- 13. Keys** — Program Directors will receive a key to the Rec Closet upon arrival. This key must be returned before the Rental leaves. A \$5.00 charge will be applied to the Rental if they lose or damage the key. Please put everything back where you found it in the Rec Closet. A \$50.00/hr. charge will be applied for however long it takes the Camp Staff to clean up the Rec Closet after your group.
